Voice Description: Unrestrained, emphatic speech; youthful.

Character Description: OUTSPOKEN. FORTHRIGHT. CONFIDENT.

In contrast to her serious older brother, Uranium is cheeky and less reserved. Uran is independent and kind-hearted, sensitive to the needs of others. A robot programmed to *act* as Atom's younger sister, she's gifted with empathy, thanks to her algorithm that can perceive people's emotions.

Uranium is also able to communicate with animals. Raised to value equality among EVERYONE, she doesn't understand society's discrimination against robots.

SCENE 1

SCENE 2

Intrigued by his artwork, URANIUM befriends a strange robot.

URANIUM: Hey mister, did you paint that?

PLUTO: Yes, there was paint in the shed.

URANIUM: Are you an artist?

PLUTO: I don't know. But I had an urge to make this.

URANIUM: Oh, I know! This is called abstract painting.

PLUTO: Abstract painting...

URANIUM: Robots can draw exactly what they see, right?

So it's rare to see a robot paint this way by choice! Or...maybe you're just bad at rough sketches.
